Coalition Updates:

Lili shared that we have 42 attendees at January's Caring for Head & Heart event. All In hosted Responsible Seller/Server training by Alcohol and Tobacco Control on February 6 for area businesses. All In Wydown were on KMOV Channel 4 for their fortune cookie project on January 26, where they handed out fortune cookies with vaping information in them during lunches. All In has a new Media Sector Representative, Matt Woods who is a digital content producer with KMOV and produced the *Contaminated: The Fentanyl Crisis* last fall. <u>PreventEd's Teen Institute</u> is now open for registration and Lili asked folks to take flyers to share with high school students who may be interested.
