Meeting Minutes for November Approved

Drug Free Communities Grant Update

- All In's Year End Financial Report has been submitted. \$51,375 remaining. Awaiting approval for carryover into the next year. Due to executive orders, DFC applicants from last year are invited to recomplete. This does not affect All In Clayton.
- Missouri Student Survey planning is underway. A survey will be given in March. The district should have data back in May or June. The district can add two additional modules to MSS. All In to submit seven additional questions for the second module.

Internal Coalition Updates

High School Coalition -

- Pilot 5th Grade Prevention Program at Glenridge. First 5th grade lesson on November 18th. Some small group activities. Sritha reports that kids were receptive. Pre- and post-tests were administered. Surveys show slight improvement. Second session scheduling is in the works.
- Spin the Wheel Activity at CHS. Students answered true or false questions about substance use.
- Poster Making Activity at CHS. Posters give students an opportunity to be creative and also share prevention messaging. Poster will be hung around CHS in January.

Wydown Coalition –

- Students are working on Prevention Posters to be hung around Wydown. Poster making started today, and will finish at the next meeting.
- Rachel Stanford to come in January to present to Wydown.

Education –

- Wydown Prevention Education Lessons. The curriculum has been built to present to 7th and 8th grade science classes. Lessons start this week. 6th grade curriculum still in progress.

Data –

- The Listening Session Planning committee has met. Pilot session in January with All In High School Coalition. Questions are being sorted and prioritized/ranked within the committee.

- Working on plans for managing our social media. High school and middle school youth have expressed interest in posting to All In social media.

Community Updates

- The City of Clayton passed a New Chapter and Amended Ordinances to ensure another vape store does not open within certain boundaries within the city of Clayton.
