Meeting Minutes

Chellie welcomed everyone and introduced herself. All other attendees introduced themselves and shared their "Why". "Why are they at the prevention table?" Thoughtful introductions ensued.

Captain Thuet shared that the police department has a number of new officers to support the community: Two new traffic officers who will focus on traffic accidents, hazardous moving violations and DWI enforcement (they are Rick Matthews and Keaton Fogler). And a new Business District Officer. His name is Seth Richardson and he will focus on problems that occur in the business districts in Clayton.

Chellie shared updates on the following initiatives:

- Alcohol Compliance Checks - Lt Jeffery DeVorss (1st one scheduled for 2/7) Al shared the police department has hired new officers including one that will focus on the Business Sector.
- Hear Us! (meet with Reps and Senators) - 3/26-3/27 - PreventEd
- Youth Town Hall Planning (Alliance for Healthy Communities & Parkway South High School)
- High School and Wydown Youth Coalitions have started meeting
- Staff Professional Development - Mental Health First Aid (includes common signs & symptoms of substance use challenges and content on trauma, substance use, self care and impact of social media and bullying)

Chellie then shared the work plan for the next 4 months:

- The Parent Community Survey will be completed.
- The Strategic Plan outline has been developed along with the Youth Environmental Scan.
- The Plan will be finished by the end of May

Chellie brought up the Sector Representative Roles that need to be filled. We plan to reach out to the Rotary to find a Civic and Volunteer Group Rep and Chellie has reached out to a restaurant owner in Clayton to see if they will represent the Business Community. Chellie will be sharing new Sector Representative Agreements with all of the representatives to update the agreements on file.
