Internal Coalition Updates

High School Coalition - Sritha Rathikindi, President

- Environmental Scan Planning: Members of the high school coalition are making plans to go out in the Clayton community to access what substances are available. Will have packets to give vendors with prevention education and legal ramifications of selling to minors.
- Elementary School Lessons: Counselors suggested elementary school lessons switch from fifth graders to fourth graders because of time constraints.
- Hear Us: Hear Us took place February 23 – 24. Seven students from Clayton attended legislative meetings in Jefferson City. Students talked to representatives about revising DWI regulations to be more punitive.

Wydown Coalition - Chellie McLellan

- Chellie shared two videos on finding your “natural high”.
- Wydown’s meeting was interrupted by a fire drill.
- Possibility of moving the coalition to an afterschool club.

Education - Wydown Prevention Education Lesson: Chellie will be teaching about alcohol and healthy choices to 6th graders at Wydown.
