Meeting Minutes for October Approved

Addressing Youth Tobacco and Nicotine Use Presentation- Rachel Sanford, Manager Health Promotions, American Lung Association

- 87.6% of youth e-cigarette users used flavored e-cigarettes (FDA National Youth Tobacco Survey, 2024)
- Oral nicotine pouch use is on the rise among youth
- No current flavored vape restrictions in the state of Missouri
- Missouri has no statewide clean air law or Tobacco21 law, and no age limit on selling tobacco/nicotine products.
- There are 23 vape shops for every 1 McDonald in the state.
- In Missouri, there is no specific tobacco license required.
